## Endbericht zur Jahrestagung der Nationalökonomischen Gesellschaft (NÖG) 2015

Die Jahrestagung 2015 der Nationalökonomischen Gesellschaft (NÖG) fand von 5. bis 6. Juni 2015 an der Alpen-Adria-Universität Klagenfurt statt.

Es wurden 55 Referate gehalten und zwar drei eingeladene Keynote Lectures (Mike Wickens, University of York; Seppo Honkapohja, Bank of Finland, und Ansgar Belke, Universität Duisburg-Essen), 52 Contributed Papers sowie eine Podiumsdiskussion zum Thema „Die Zukunft des Euro“, an der Ewald Nowotny (Oesterreichische Nationalbank), Peter Gauper (Raiffeisen Landesbank Kärnten), Willi Semmler (New School for Social Research, New York), Ansgar Belke (Universität Duisburg-Essen) sowie Thomas Gehrig (Universität Wien) als eingeladene Sprecher teilnahmen.

Das Hauptthema der Tagung lautete „The Future of the European Economic and Monetary Union: European Monetary and Fiscal Policies“. Darüber hinaus konnten Vorträge aus allen Teilgebieten der Nationalökonomie eingereicht werden. Das hohe Niveau der Tagung zeigt sich daran, dass zahlreiche Papers abgelehnt wurden. Insgesamt wurden die meisten Vorträge von lebhaften Diskussionen begleitet.

Die besten Beiträge der Tagung werden nach einem internationalen Begutachtungsverfahren in der Zeitschrift der Nationalökonomischen Gesellschaft, *Empirica - Journal of European Economics*, im kommenden Jahr veröffentlicht werden.

Das ausführliche Programm der Tagung liegt diesem Bericht bei.

Wie auf jeder Jahrestagung der Nationalökonomischen Gesellschaft wurden auch auf dieser drei Young Economist Awards für die besten Vorträge von Verfassern unter 35 Jahren verliehen. Einer dieser Preise erging an Dr. Dmitri Blüschke vom Institut für Volkswirtschaftslehre und seinen Koautor Ivan Savin (Universität Jena).
